## Publication of Staff Diversity Data

## 1 January 2017

The Specific duties of the Equality Act 2010 require public bodies to;

- publish information relating to employees who share protected characteristics
- publish information relating to people who are affected by the public body's policies and practices (e.g. students)

The following information is designed to give an overall indication of the position of the University with respect to those protected characteristics about which data is currently collected. It is used to guide further equalities work and further analysis may be possible where there are particular concerns.

University figures are given in two tables; staff (less atypical staff) and results of the Staff Survey 2016 where appropriate. The UK HEI figures are based on data provided by the Equality Challenge Unit which provides representations of the protected characteristics for all staff in UK HEl's.

## Notes:

Where figures are given for UK HEl's (Higher Education Institutes), these are for the Academic Year 2014/15 which are the latest available.
The percentages in brackets indicate last year's representation at the University of Leicester produced in January 2016 and UK HEI's for academic year 2013/14.

The staff survey results are based on data from the staff survey between February and March 2016. There were 2,689 completed staff survey questionnaires from 4,051 employees invited to participate; the figures in the report relate to these $66 \%$.
